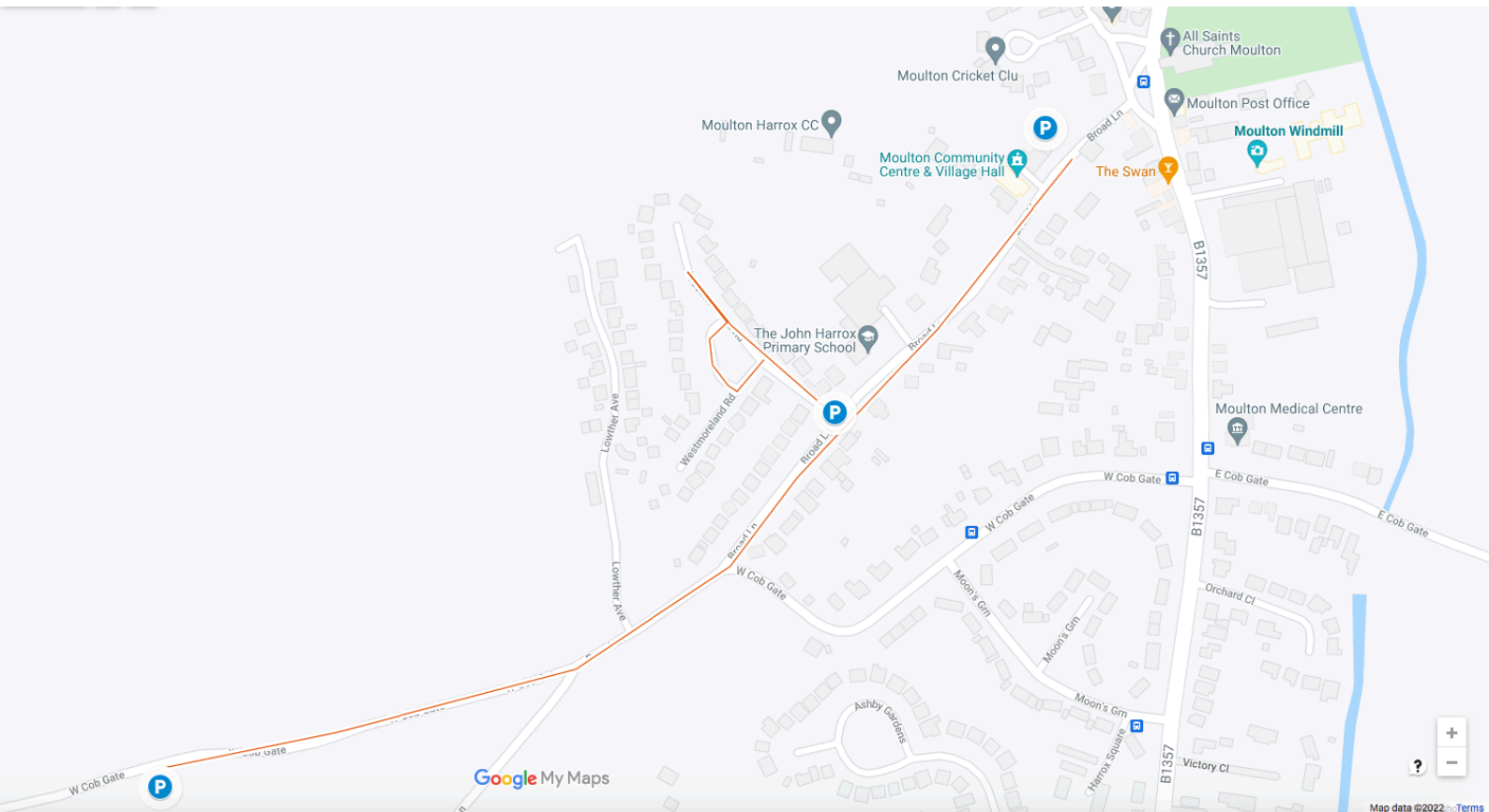

Parking : The parking at the HQ is very limited with only 25 space. Further parking off the street is available at **Peloton Produce** 0.5 miles away along Broad Lane. Please only park in the village if both car parks become full and please park respectfully.



Official vehicles are to park at the HQ and on Broad Lane in a designated area outside of the HQ.



Rider safety guide

This race is run under British Cycling's technical regulations and under standard highway conditions therefore you MUST abide by the rules of the road.

Safety

- You are not on closed roads and you will face oncoming traffic

Marshals (static or moto)

- Direct riders around the course and warn other road users a race is taking place
- Marshals do not create road closures or make it safe to race on the right hand side of the road

Actions

- You are responsible for your own actions
- Race on the left hand side of the road – do not cross solid white lines and always avoid crossing broken white lines
- Persistent offenders will be penalised (eg disqualification or a fine)
- If necessary the race will be stopped

Responsibility

- Look after each other, behave responsibly and safely
- Do not take unnecessary risks - your actions could have serious consequences

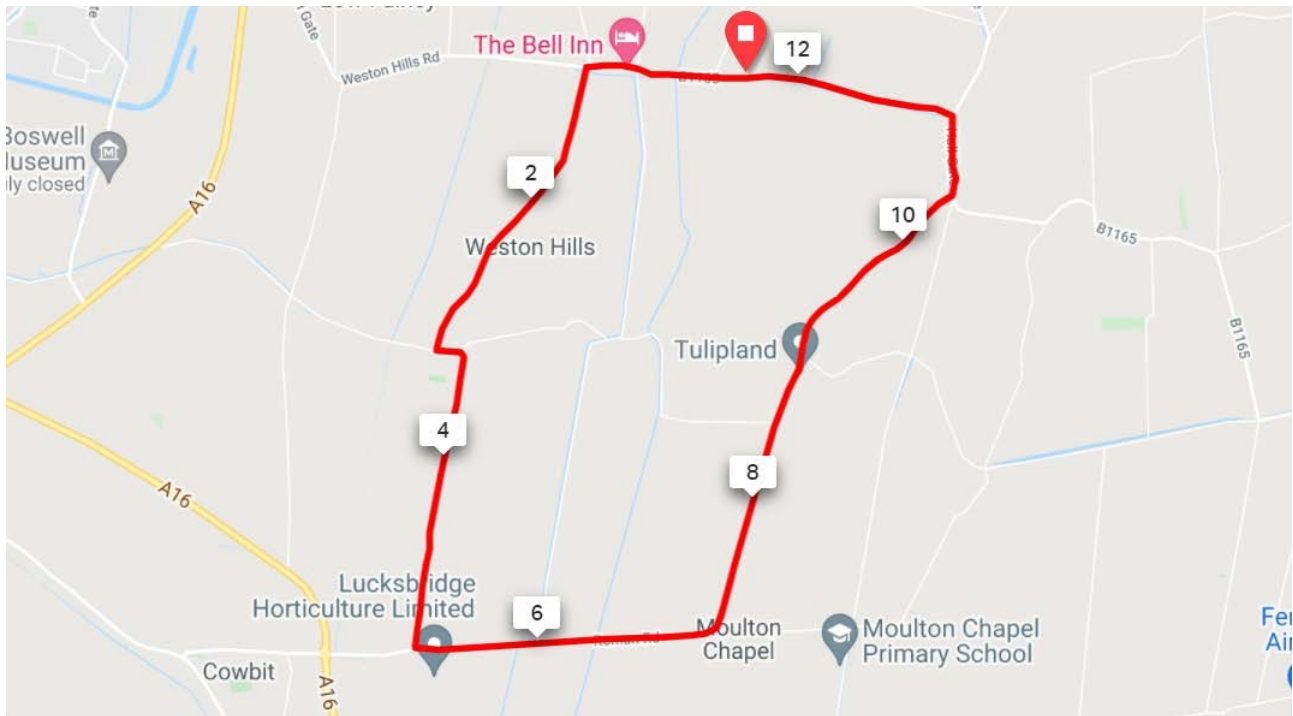

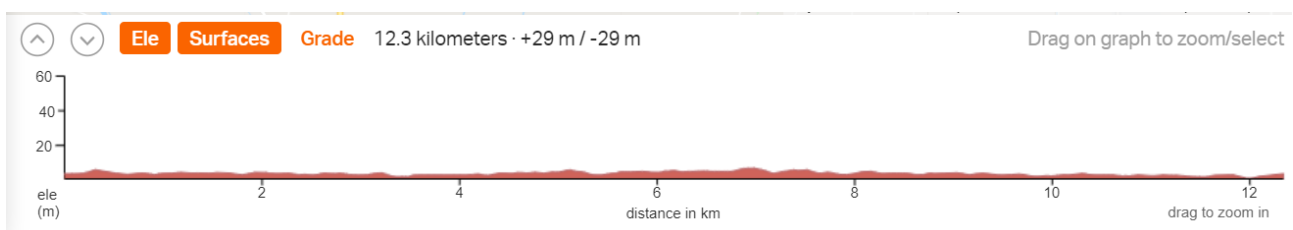

Course Details : A rural course on a mix of 'B' and unclassified roads passing through Weston Hills and Moulton Chapel villages. A flat open Fenland course with minimal evaluation gain and little protection from the elements. There are several tight 90° corners some of which have limited visibility of the approaching race to any on-coming traffic all of which will be controlled by accredited marshals. There are several stretches of road that do not have central white lines.

The roads are generally in good condition however several areas have poor edges leading into small dykes.



Elevation gain



Finish Area : The finish is along the B1165 - Austendyke Road just before Long Lane. Approximately 1 mile after the last corner on the circuit. There will be no parking next to the finish, so spectators please park on the side roads near by along Long Lane or Moulton Mere Bank. After the race riders can ride back along Long Lane to the HQ.

Feed Zone : There is a designated feed zone just past the finish opposite the junction to Moulton Mere Bank. However this is a very fast flat course so feeding will be very difficult and I would discourage you to attempt feeding due to the nature of the course.

Please Note : Protection for riders and the race convoy is provided by motor cycle marshals and a team of static marshals. The moto-marshals cover one point on the course, then when the race has passed, move on to the next point on the course where they are needed to provide protection to the race.

Riders: please ensure that you keep to the left-hand side of the road to allow the moto-marshals to pass the peloton. If a moto marshal is behind you and sounding the horn, that means that he needs to overtake you to move ahead of the race. You must ensure that you move to the left-hand side of the course in a safe and controlled manner to allow the marshals to pass.

Safety cover for riders to race is limited to when you are between the first lead car and the final vehicle in the race convoy – Red Broom Wagon

If you are dropped from the bunch and fall behind the Broom Wagon you are no longer in the zone of safety cover provided by the race marshals.

You cannot assume that marshals will be present at turns or junctions to indicate the way or stop traffic.

You must follow the normal rules of the road, follow the Highway Code and respect other road users when you are outside the protection of the race.

It is your responsibility to follow the race route exactly.

Rider Numbers

Place numbers on your jersey as below. No aero suit pockets, numbers must be pinned on the outside.
